Mowing

We are in the process of agreeing mowable areas with the landlord; clarification will follow shortly, so see John Stevens before mowing.

Pits position

As advised last time: We have moved the pits uphill away from the patch. This is required by BMFA safety guidelines, it should reduce any risk of an overshoot landing in the pits area.

Pits shape

As advised last time: We have made the pits wider and shallower, this should allow everyone to set-up on the uphill edge of the pits, facing the patch, and with no need to thread through others while carrying / wheeling their model to and fro.

Hovering patch

The hovering patch has moved northward, it is now beyond the pits.
