# **R/C Simulators**

#### Are

Computer programs to simulate radio control flying, some can also act like flight simulators, while others can help design custom models.

## Differ from flight simulators

R/C simulators show what you see from the ground; flight simulators show you the view from inside the aircraft.

N.B. Most R/C simulators can switch point of view to inside your model.

#### Cost

Free (FMS) €30 Aerofly £130 (reflex)

Practice with-out breaking real models, Introduce beginners to basic concepts of orientation etc, Hover practice for helicopters.

## What do you need

A PC with a fairly good graphics card A transmitter interface to connect your TX to the PC as a joystick
