#### **AGM**

Our annual general meeting was on 28<sup>th</sup> November, which unfortunately coincided with the BMFA AGM; (no this didn't mean all our members where getting elected to the national committee), but it does mean that our treasurer had to assume that the BMFA recommendation of £27 for seniors members. Happily the BMFA did vote this in.

Dave Garratt presented his estimates for our probable costs next year, these had small increases built in (allowing for inflation). The figures where :-
