This years AGM

This was held on 25th November. High-lights where

- A volunteer for the committee

 Mark Kaleda hopes to add few new ideas and energy to the club in his role as chairman.
- Increase in fees □ thanks mostly due the theft of the mower, of grass cutting costs have gone up a lot, forcing the treasurer to recommend an increase of £10 to the full (senior) membership; this is now £37 for club membership plus £28 for BMFA membership. The motion to accept this passed easily □ a clear sign that we provide very good value for money.
- A suggestion that we attempt to increase permitted flying times at Merriott.
- The patch is now being mown for us at a very reasonable £20 per cut.
- Proposal that we put some effort into an improved/new web site (see new website contact).
- We now have permission to fly helicopters at Westlands on Sundays.
- With the opening of Lynash Nurseries to the public, we will be reassessing the Merriott no-fly areas, and possibly shifting/turning/reshaping the flying patch.

This years Accounts

The treasurer presented the accounts at the AGM, full versions are available from him, but a quick (unofficial) summary is :-

- Income for 2008 was £882, but expenditure reached £927. This includes an unexpected £80 in mowing costs following the theft of the mower.
- The estimate for next year sexpenditure is £1285. Most of this increase is due to moving costs, slightly offset by not having to pay for petrol, servicing or repairs.
- The estimated number of senior members is 35
- With the increased club subscription of £37, we should almost break even.

Site changes (Merriott)

- Mark (thanks) has replaced the chain across the bottom of the entrance with a rope. This isntlocked, but please unhook it (or you may damage your car), and of course put it back afterwards.
- Please put the grey box containing the logbook, in the waterproof bag.
- Please remember to use the frequency pegboard (which should now hold to the pole).

- When closed to full sized aircraft.
- Flying should cease at sunset on either site.
- NOT all electric models are silent, please be considerate.
- 4 Helicopters only.
