## Impending loss of Merriott site

Following complaints about noise and over-flying of the nursery, we where given notice to quit the field. After some negotiation by Dave Garrett & Mark Kaleda, and following relocation of the flying patch, we now have provisional permission to continue flying until December. Be extra careful, one forgetful moment could get us thrown off at a day's notice; please:-

- No more than 4 aircraft in the air at once.
- Respect the No-fly zones if you aren't confident of landing without overlying the no-fly zone, please wait for the wind to change.
- Remember to flying time rules.

## Finding a new site

We definitely need a new flying site (our landlord has been about as flexible as he is likely to be already). Thus:-

- Buying a site is beyond the club's means (Unless some one gets lucky on the lottery).
  - The editor has set up email notification from the big on-line estate agents just in case something good comes up.
- Please be on the lookout for any opportunities
  - Dave Garrett & Mark Pope are looking at something on 29-30<sup>th</sup> June
- We will have a poster advert for local events
  - The poster will be on the Newsletter archive site, once it's finished.
  - An advert in the Western Gassette is being considered.
  - Posting on a notice board at Mole Valley Farmers has been suggested.

#### **Events**

This club has committed to the following events:

- Westland Leisure Complex Open Weekend on 30th August (we are not involved on the Saturday).
  - This is where the grant for training aircraft came from so we really should make an effort to support this event.
  - We hope to organise some buddy box flying, demonstrations and a few static models. We have space both indoors in the sports hall, and outdoors on the Cricket Pitch. The sports hall has a couple of mains sockets to allow recharging, and plenty of height, but we may not have all 4 badminton courts; so high-speed indoor fliers may be curtailed. The editor has a little Blade MCX helicopter, which can be used with a buddy leaded indoors. We need others to help (particularly a helicopter flier since James Moon can't attend).
  - Outdoors we need some "park-fly" sized models, plus static display.
- Chard Fun Day on 12th September at the Cresta Leisure Centre, Chard. Jan has
  offered the use of a tent, PA system & pegboard. We some people to help erect and
  dismantle the tent. Also we need Models for the static and flying shows.





## **Dortmund 2010**

The editor has one of the local travel agents investigating the possibility of a coach trip to the Dortmund 2010 model fair. I expect the trip to be 1 day outbound, 3 days at the show, and 1 day travelling home. My previous experience of this was from Preston via Hull, ferry to Rotterdam, (with a brief stop over at Arnhem); from Somerset the possibilities for stops will be different. The cost will depend on the numbers interested, and will include hotel, coach, ferry and tickets.

No firm commitment required at this stage, but I need an idea of numbers, so would any one interested please call me?
