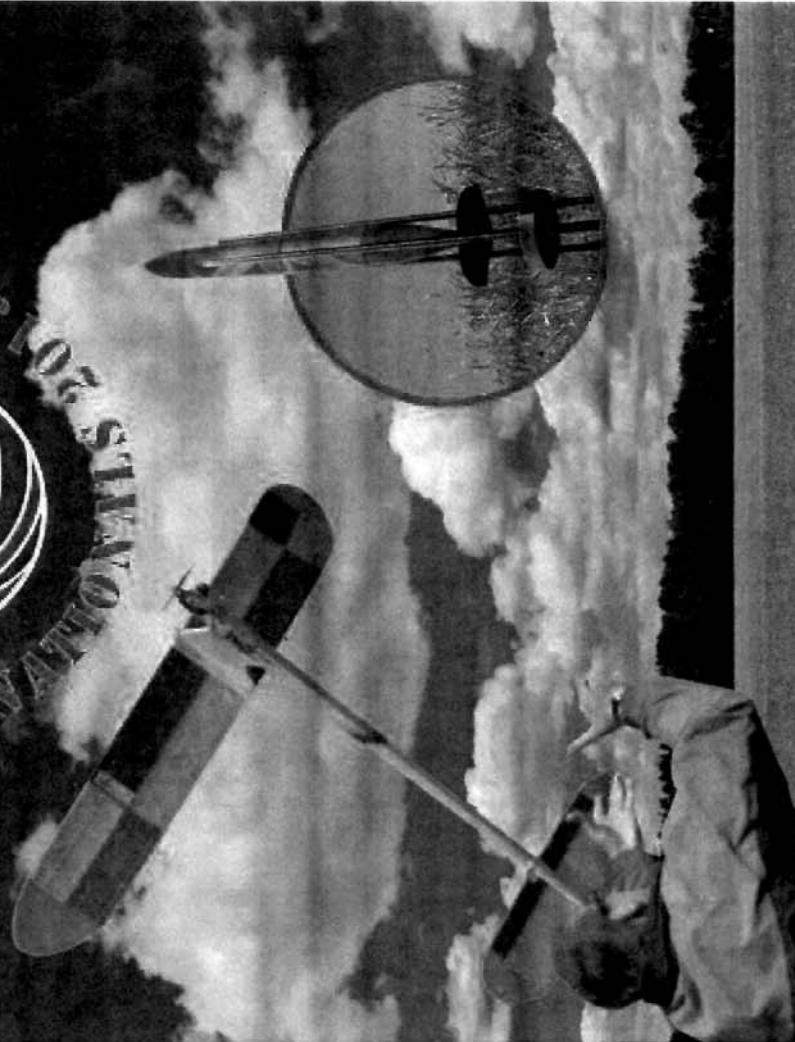

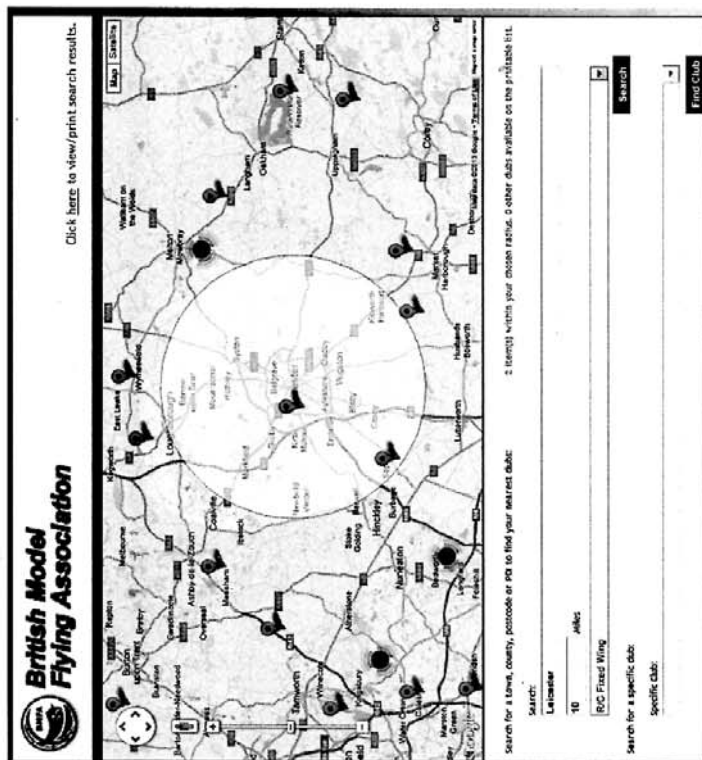

The final developments of the interactive club map have now been completed. Clubs can now specify which Club contact, flying site location and other information they wish to be added to the map.

The Club map offers the facility to search for clubs in a specific area and filter those results by discipline. There is also a search facility for specific clubs.

The current information used has been gathered over the past year however we need all clubs to check they are shown and listed and also confirm that correct information is displayed. Please click on 'Submit club details' from the club map website to provide updated information. Some clubs will not wish to display their exact location however you may provide co-ordinates nearby if you wish.

Trial flights have been added to the disciplines that clubs can offer, we will be producing a leaflet, available from the BMFA stand and RC simulator trailer and reproduced in the press, explaining to potential new members how they can search for clubs in their area and see which clubs can offer a trial flight so they can experience flying a real RC aircraft for themselves.

Notice to Club Examiners – Achievement Scheme Tests and Non BMFA Members.

The BMFA achievement schemes have always been open to all model flyers, the only requirement being that non BMFA members provide proof of suitable insurance cover prior to taking any test. Previously, a minimum of £5 million liability cover has been stipulated, however this level of cover is no longer considered adequate and going forward the same cover provided to BMFA members must be in place.

In order to facilitate this and ensure adequate levels of cover are in place for all parties the BMFA insurers have agreed to provide suitable cover to non member test candidates for the duration of the test day at no additional cost.

From 1st March 2013, BMFA examiners testing non BMFA members must notify the office no later than the day prior to the test and provide the candidates name, address and the date the test will be conducted in order that the additional cover can be activated.
